DONATING TO THE CLOTHES CLOSET

FBC accepts all types of clothing: shirts, pants, dresses, suits, shoes, belts, coats, hats, etc. NEW socks and underwear are always needed.

If you would like to donate clothing, please use the following guidelines:

- Clothing should be new or gently used. Please do not donate items that are stained/dirty, torn, or have been in a home with a smoker.
- Drop off clothing in the FBC front lobby on St. Clair Street, Monday - Thursday, 8:00 am - 3:00 pm.
- Please do not bring household items.
