



ABOUT THE MISSION FRANKFORT CLINIC

The objective of the Mission Frankfort Clinic (MFC) is to provide basic medical, dental, and pharmaceutical care to the uninsured of Franklin County. Open most Wednesday evenings plus one Saturday per month, all services are free of charge.

The Mission Frankfort Clinic was founded by First Baptist Church of Frankfort, Kentucky. The dental clinic started in September 2002 with the medical and pharmaceutical services beginning in 2004. As of 2020, MFC averages approximately 800 to 1,000 appointments per year.
